REMEMBERING A FRIEND AND COLLEAGUE

Mahidhara was one of the most active volunteers in the global profession. He was the first Indian member to be elected to the Council of the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries and championed the IFoA's work in wider fields, particularly data science and banking. He also volunteered generously with the Institute of Actuaries of India and the International Actuarial Association.

CREATING A LEGACY WITH IMPACT

THE IFOA FOUNDATION MAHIDHARA APPEAL has been set up to celebrate his life and honour his memory. With an overall target of £55,000, this appeal could unlock the Foundation's potential to have even greater impact in South Asia.

An example of one of these projects, as an enduring tribute to Mahidhara, is the creation of **THE MAHIDHARA DAVANGERE SOUTH ASIA SCHOLARSHIP FUND**. This will support the most promising actuarial students in South Asia who need financial assistance to continue their education, and help qualified actuaries to have more sustainable careers. The Foundation developed this concept with input from Mahidhara himself, so it seems fitting that it will now bear his name.
