

Introduction

Welcome to the ASSA F107/B100 Tuition Course.

This course aims to provide you with a practical understanding of the Banking principles together with an understanding of the actuarial work involved in a Banking Entity. It will cover all aspects of the F107/B100 course for the Actuarial Society of South African examinations.

Pre-Course Reading

The readings and assignment specified must be completed before each lecture, as lecture discussions will assume that you have read the required material and completed the assignment.

The recommended additional reading is not required and is specified only if you wish to read further on the subject matter. Although these readings are not required, we suggest that you read as much as you can. We find that those students who read around the subject matter tend to have a greater understanding of the material and consequently a greater chance of performing well in the exam.

Self-Assessment

As you progress through the Course there will sometimes be quizzes or assignments to assess your level of understanding. It is advisable that you read up on the questions you get wrong to ensure that you understand and can apply your knowledge.

Assignments will be **due every Monday morning at 08:00hrs SAST** ¹following all non-assignment feedback lectures. Separate feedback sessions will be set up for assignment feedback.

Content Practice Exam

This tuition course includes a 3 hour long, 100 marks Content Practice Exam (CPE) to be taken at the end of the series of lectures. It is highly recommended to take the exam. Detailed feedback will be provided on each attempt and there will be an interactive CPE feedback session to discuss the paper and any questions the students have. The CPE is current scheduled to be open for attempt from **08:00hrs Friday the 6th of October to 20:00hrs Sunday the 8th of October 2023**.

Guidance on Study Hours and Examination Preparation
