## See Rule 13 of the Disciplinary Scheme, and the Case Report and **Adjudication Panel Regulations**

\*Sanctions:

- A reprimand; and/or
- a fine, up to the maximum amount detailed in the Regulations (£10,000); and/or
- a compulsory period of education, retraining and/or supervised practice; and/ or
- exclusion from membership of the IFoA up to a maximum period of five years ONLY if the Respondent is no longer a Member at the time the Adjudication Panel makes its determination.


